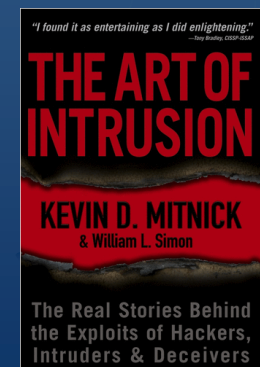
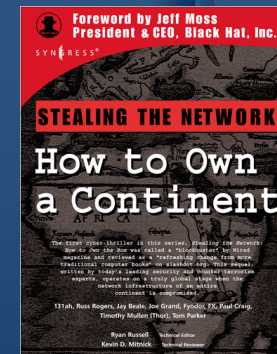
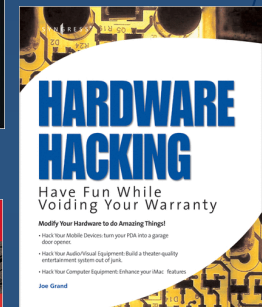
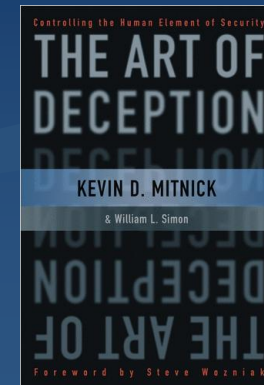
- **Handle:** Condor
- **Arrested:** Feb 15, 1995
- **Charged:** Sept 26, 1996 (pleaded guilty to wire and computer fraud)
- **Convicted:** Mar 18, 1999
- **Released:** Jan 11, 2000
- **Crime:** From the September 26, 1996 court record: "obtaining unauthorized access to computers belonging to numerous computer software and computer operating systems manufacturers, cellular telephone manufacturers, Internet Service Providers, and educational institutions; and (b) stealing, copying, and misappropriating proprietary computer software" from "Motorola, Fujitsu, Nokia, Sun, Novell, and NEC."
- After being incarcerated, awaiting full trial for 4 years, Kevin served 10 additional months and was released on conditional probation - He may not use a computer, cellular phone, or any other Internet device until 2003, nor profit from his crimes in any way. Total time spent in prison for this offense was 4 years, 11 months, and 6 days.

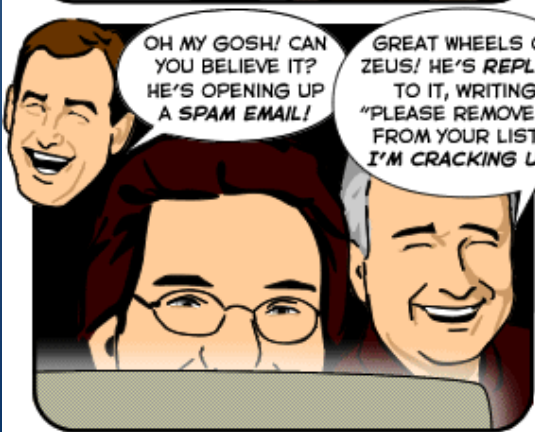
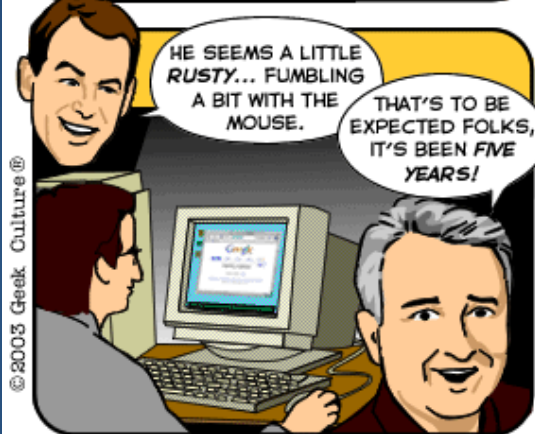
